SIR,

In forwarding herewith a copy of letter from the President, Bezwada Taluk Board Ref No.1673 dated 13th November 1907, I have the honour to request that Government may be pleased to sanction, from Provincial funds, a sum of Rs 3,000 required by the President for the necessary improvements to the Rural School buildings already constructed from the Provincial grant. If the required improvements are not made soon the amount already spent on their construction may become a waste in many cases. The Taluk Board cannot spare any amount from its own Local Fund Revenue for the purpose. Government help is therefore urgently and unavoidably required.

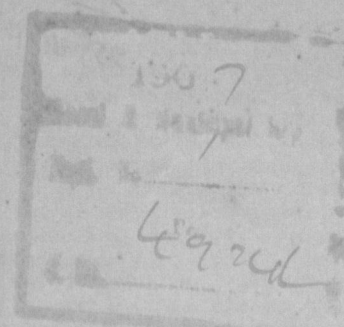

Copy of letter R.C.No.1673/T.B.of 1907 dated 13th November 1907 from

the President, Taluk Board, Bezwada, to the President, District Board,

Kistna.

I have the honour to state that some of the Rural School buildings require improvements, and repairs in the interests of the buildings themselves not to speak of the extensions necessary to meet the present requirements of the schools. Verandahs are necessary as their absence has caused the walls to crumble away in many places. In view of these considerations coupled with the crippled finances of the Taluk Board, I request that you will be so good as to move Government through the Director of Public Instruction to sanction a grant of at least Rs 3,000 for the purpose so as to enable the proposed works to be executed and paid for before the end of the current official year.

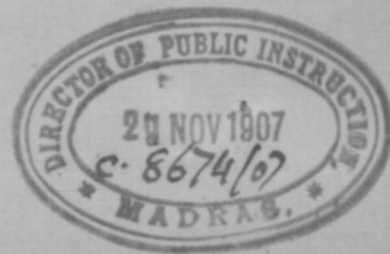

2. I do not think applications of this kind should be entertained now. The buildings are the property of the Local Boards and their upkeep may be considered a legitimate charge on their revenues. If the improvements are absolutely necessary and if the Board cannot find funds for them, it may, perhaps, be allowed to divert for this purpose the sum of Rs 3,000 sanctioned for new buildings in G.O. No. 736, Educational, dated 4th November 1907.
