Sir,

Since the death of Dewan Bahadur V. Krishnamachariyar, the Registrar of Books, on the 29th October 1907, my Personal Assistant M.R.Ry V. Krishnaswami Jatavallabhar, B.A., has under my orders been in charge of the office of Registrar of Books until Rao Bahadur M. Rangachariyar took over charge on the 19th instant. During the above period he attended to all the office and correspondence work, the only business left over for the new Registrar being the signing of the receipts in connection with the registration of the books delivered at the office. The work was outside the sphere of his legitimate duties and had to be performed in addition to them. I have therefore the honour to recommend that he be granted the

Submitted that there is no provision in the Printing Presses and Books Act (XXV of 1867) under the rules framed thereunder that the Director of Public Instruction is exofficio Registrar of Books. Section 18 of the Act says that the registration should be made "at such office and by such officer as the Local Government shall appoint in this behalf."

2. The Director of Public Instruction states that since the death of Dewan Bahadur V. Krishnama Chariyar, the late Registrar of Books, on the 29th October 1907, M.R.Ry.V. Krishnaswami Jatavallabar, the Personal Assistant to the Director of Public Instruction was, under his ^(Director's) orders, in charge of the office of the Registrar of Books until Rao Bahadur M. Rangachariyar took over charge on the 19th Instant. He further states that the work was outside the sphere of the legitimate duties of his Personal Assistant and had to be performed in addition to them, and ^{he} therefore recommends that
