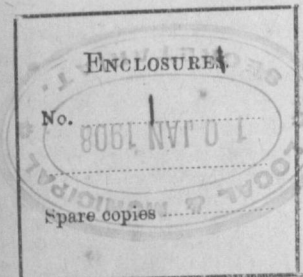

Under note (2) to clause (5) of the Special Test Notification, the Criminal Judicial Test Lower Grade, is open only to persons who have passed the First Examination in Arts or to students of the College of Agriculture, who have passed the examination prescribed for admission ~~to the~~ to the College and have obtained the diploma in Agriculture at the Government Technical Examinations and also to candidates who have passed either the Upper Secondary or the Matriculation Examination and have obtained the diploma in Commerce at the Government Technical Examinations.

2. The candidate, in whose behalf a recommendation has now been made by the Inspector-General of Police, has only passed the Matriculation Examination and the Handwriting Test, and is not therefore eligible to appear for the Criminal Judicial Test, Lower Grade, unless specially permitted by Government. The candidate (M. Anantha Prabhu) is ~~now~~ stated to have passed the Account Test Higher, Precis Writing Test, Translation Test (Lower) in Canarese and the *Police* departmental test. 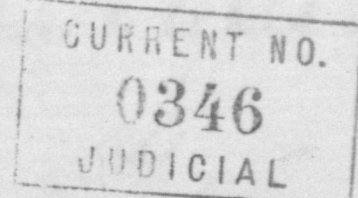
