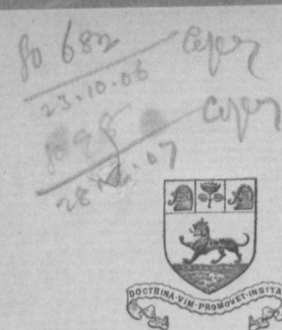

In his letters No. 2398, dated 22nd September 1906 and No. 53, dated 19th February 1907, the Registrar of the University of Madras drew the attention of Govt. to the defects noticed by the Commission for the inspection of affiliated colleges, in the colleges under the Management of Govt. The observations of the Commission were forwarded to the D.P.S. who was requested to report what steps he had taken or proposed to take to remedy the several defects pointed out - vide G.O. No. 682 Esd dated 23rd October 1906 and No. 98 Esd. dated 28th February 1907.

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2- The Director's report of the steps taken or proposed to be taken will be found in his letter on pages 2 and 3 of G.O. No. 344 Esd. dated 5th June 1907.
