Sir,

The Agent and Manager of the Madras Railway Company proposes to purchase 9 sets of books at a cost of Rs 1000/- for the use of the libraries of all the nine schools under the management of the Company and applies for a half grant of Rs 500. The list of books to be purchased has been approved by the Inspector. I have, therefore, the honour to recommend under Article 44 of the Code of Regulations for European Schools that a half grant not exceeding Rs 500 may be sanctioned.

2. The grant, if sanctioned, may be paid from the next year's allotment. Out of the current year's allotment of Rs 6,000/- payment of a sum of Rs 2529/- has already been authorized and the balance will be utilized before the close of the
