SUBJECT

Permission to S.H. Seshadri, to appear for the Criminal judic. Test Lower Grade.

The Jy. of Police (Mr. Horne) recommends that permission may be granted to S.H. Seshadri to appear for the Criminal Judicial Test lower grade, at the examinations to be held in 1908 & 1909. in order that he may qualify himself for an Accountant's post in a District Police office.

2. The candidate is a clerk on Rs 20 in the District Police office, Guntur. As he is only a Matriculate (with handwriting test) he cannot, ~~except under~~ according to note 2 to Rule 5 of the Special Tests Notification, appear for the Special Test in question, ^(Criminal Jud. Test. Lower) except with ~~the~~ the permission of Government. He has passed the Precise Writing Test, Account^{Test} Higher and the Departmental Test and the Jy. of Police says he is reported to be a good clerk. Mr. Horne also says that qualified men are rare in the Telugu districts.

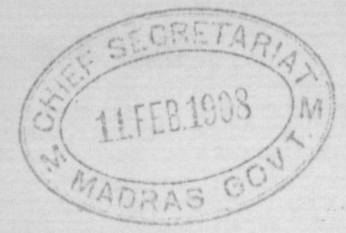

The length of service of S.H. Seshadri is however, not given. The application is mainly based on personal grounds, but in Col. 9 of the application, it is stated that "Qualified men are rare in the Telugu districts". Perhaps the Judicial Department may first be consulted.
