SUBJECT

Permission to Mr. J.H. Stone to undertake the duties of Registrar of the Madras University

Under Article 74 of the Civil Service Regulations an officer may receive a fee from a private person or private body or a public body whose funds are not administered by Government for work done for it - provided

- (1) he has undertaken the work with the knowledge and sanction in writing of the head of his department;
- (2) the head of the department certifies that it can be carried without detriment to his official duties; and
- (3) that the acceptance of a fee and the amount of the fee are approved by the authority having power to sanction its acceptance."

2. It is presumed that the D.P.J. has permitted Mr. Stone to undertake the duties of the Registrar in addition to his own official duties as Principal. Dr. Bourne certifies that Mr. Stone has undertaken to do the

the work after College hours.

3. Under Clause (c) of Art. 74 of the C.S.R., the sanction of the Government of India will be necessary for the acceptance of the remuneration, if it should exceed Rs 500. In the present case, the remuneration is Rs 300 per mensem and the arrangement is expected to last for only about a month. It is not therefore likely that a reference to India will be necessary for sanction to the acceptance of the remuneration by Mr. Stone.

4. It is submitted that it would be enough on the present reference to ~~Sanct~~ permit Mr. Stone to undertake the duties of Registrar of the University. Sanction to the acceptance of the remuneration may begin when the actual period for he has performed these duties and the exact amount of remuneration due to him are known.

5. Under Regulation 144 of the University Regulations the appointment of Registrar rests with the Syndicate, subject to the confirmation of the Senate.
