Sanctioning a maximum grant of Rs. 3,000 towards the cost of extending the building occupied by the Tirukkattupalli High school, Tanjore district.

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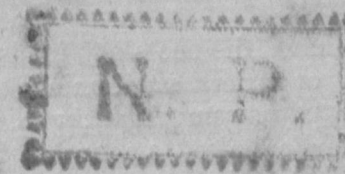

Letter—from the Hon'ble Mr. T. T. LOGAN, B.A., Acting Director of Public Instruction, Madras.

I have the honour to submit the enclosed plans with estimate amounting to Rs. 9,190 for the construction of additional accommodation for the Tirukkattupalli High school and to recommend that a third grant amounting to Rs. 3,063 may be sanctioned to be paid during the next official year.

2. The school has recently been recognized with the fifth form as the highest and a sixth form is to be opened early next year.

3. The proposed work consists of (1) a building with four rooms, (2) a compound wall, (3) a tiffin shed, and (4) a latrine. Of the four rooms, two are to be used as class rooms, while the remaining two are to be used as laboratory and the library and retiring room for teachers. The present accommodation is insufficient and the additions now contemplated are in accordance with the departmental instructions given when the school was recognized.

4. The managing authorities have the necessary funds and are ready to begin the work immediately on receipt of orders sanctioning the grant. I have been informed by the Hon'ble Mr. P. S. Sivaswami Aiyar, who is directly interested in the school, that subscriptions so far promised amount to Rs. 6,000 and that he has promised a donation of Rs. 10,000. From this sum of Rs. 16,000 the cost of purchase of the site and of building will be met.

5. In view of the total amount of building grants already paid or promised from the current year's allotment it is impossible to guarantee payment during the current official year.

6. An application for aid in the form prescribed is submitted.

II

Letter—from the Hon'ble Mr. A. G. BOURNE, D.Sc., F.R.S., Director of Public Instruction, Madras.

I have the honour to request that permission may be given at once to the management of the Tirukkattupalli High school to commence the construction of a building for the school without prejudice to their application for grant for this purpose which is at present under consideration of Government.

The application was submitted to Government with my letter R.C. No. 5173, dated 12th September 1907.

III

Memorandum No. 48-1, Educational, dated 13th January 1908.

The management of the Tirukkattupalli High school will be permitted as a special case to commence the work of constructing a building for the school without prejudice to their application for a grant for that purpose which is now under the consideration of Government on the distinct understanding that no guarantee is given that any particular amount of grant or any grant whatever will be sanctioned towards its cost.

To the Director of Public Instruction.

Note by the Chief Engineer, Public Works Department, dated 14th February 1908, No. 70-T.

The estimate amounting to Rs. 9,190 for extending the Tirukkattupalli High school, Tanjore district, is recommended for sanction with the following remarks.

The walls might be made 1' 6" thick instead of 1' 10½" as shown, and foundations laid as per sketch on the tracing. The actual depth to be settled when the nature of soil, sub-soil are known. The abutments of the verandah are weak and for stability should be 3' 6" thick.

The following arrangement is suggested:—

Two abutments		3' 6"	7' 0"
Eleven piers		2' 9"	30' 3"
Twelve archways		5' 8½"	68' 1½"

The compound wall might be made 9" thick and all below proportionately reduced. Plasters 1½" × 1½" may be provided at intervals of 10'. As regards the out-houses two coats of plaster are sufficient. The timber scantlings are sufficiently strong but wall plates under joists 3" × 4" and cambu pieces over the beams 6" × 5" tapering to 2" should be provided.

Order—No. 136, Educational, dated 24th February 1908.

The Government are pleased to sanction a maximum grant of Rs. 3,000 towards the cost of extending the building occupied by the Tirukkattupalli High school, Tanjore district, subject to the following conditions:—

(1) that in carrying out the work the suggestions of the Chief Engineer in his note read above are adopted;

(2) that the work is completed before the 31st of January 1909;

(3) that a certificate of the actual expenditure incurred on the work is submitted before the 15th February 1909;

(4) that the amount expended on the work does not fall short of Rs. 9,000 as actually verified;

(5) that all other conditions prescribed in the Grant-in-Aid Code have been duly complied with.

2. On the above conditions being fulfilled, the grant will be paid as funds become available.
