As the sanction accorded in G.O. No. 730, Educa-
tional, dated 2nd November 1907 for the retention of the
temporary establishment of the School of Arts expires with the
31st March next and as notice of dispensing with their services
is to be served on the members on the 29th instant unless the
sanction is meanwhile renewed, I have the honour to request that
Government may be pleased to accord sanction to the continuance
of the establishment until the re-organization of the school,
proposals regarding which are under my consideration, is sanctioned.

U. In G.O. No.730, Educational, dated 2nd
November 1907, the Government sanctioned the
retention of the temporary establishment of the
School of Arts up to 31st March 1908 or until the
reorganization of the School of Arts, whichever
was earlier, subject to the condition that the
services of the establishment would be dispensed
with at any time on giving a month's notice.

L. 2. In G.O. No.840, Educational, dated 18th
December 1907, the Director of Public Instruction
was ~~directed~~ to call on Mr. Hadaway, the new
Superintendent of the School of Arts, to submit
his proposals for the reorganization of the
school.

3. The Director of Public Instruction
(Dr. Bourne) now reports that he has under his
consideration the proposals submitted by Mr.
Hadaway, and as the notice to the temporary
establishment, if their services are to be
dispensed with after 31st March 1908, has to
be served on the 29th instant, the Director
requests that sanction may be accorded to the
retention of the establishment until the reorgani-
zation of the school is sanctioned.

4. It is for consideration whether the Director's recommendation may be accepted. It is not possible to state with any approach to accuracy when the scheme for the re-organization of the School of Arts will be sanctioned. Nor is any information furnished as to whether the scheme is one which will require the sanction of the Government of India or the Secretary of State. At the same time it does not appear to be desirable to sanction the retention of the temporary establishment for an indefinite period.

~~until the scheme of reorganization is sanctioned~~
Perhaps the retention of the temporary establishment may be sanctioned, ^{subject to the usual condition as regards notice} up to 1st June next, by which ^{time} the scheme of reorganization may be

expected to be before Government, when it may be possible to form some estimate of the probable date by which it will be sanctioned. In the meantime, the Director of Public Instruction may be asked to expedite the proposals for the reorganization called for in G.O.No.840 Education dated 17th December 1907.

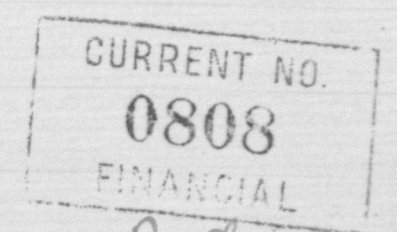

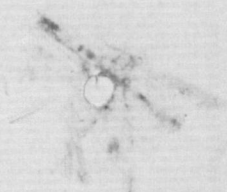
