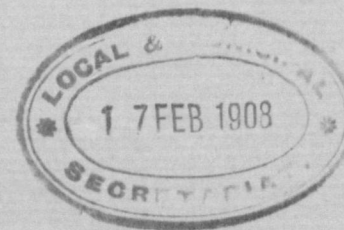

Most respectfully sheweth,

That your Excellency's Memorialist belongs to the foremost family of the Mopla Community in South Canara District, which pays an assessment of over Rs. 1000 per annum; that the Government has been pleased to nominate his eldest brother as a Taluk Board member; another brother is employed as a Sub-Inspector of Police, and a third brother is studying for Mechanical Engineering in the Victoria Jubilee Technical Institute at Bombay; that his forefathers were entrusted with responsible posts in the Government of the country under the Mysore Circar.

2. That he has studied up to the Fifth Form in the Government College, Mangalore, and knows to read, write, and speak English and Canarese thoroughly well.

3. That he applied for a Sub-Inspectorship in the Police Department during the late selection of candidates held by the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Southern Range, at Mangalore in October last, and was selected by him as an approved candidate, he having been strongly recommended in the first instance by the District Collector and Magistrate Khan Sahib, M. Azizuddin Sahib Bahadur and the District Superintendent of Police H. R. G. Hasted Esq.

4. That the recommendation of the Deputy Inspector General of Police, who had personally satisfied himself about his fitness and had every opportunity of judging of his intelligence and capabilities, was approved of by the Inspector General of Police, Madras.

5. That accordingly his name was sent up to the Government of Madras for exempting him from the necessary examination rules; but the Memorialist is greatly aggrieved to find that the Government, who knows fully well the backwardness of the community to which he belongs and who has publicly and repeatedly declared its intention to encourage the Mopla community in their educational as well as their general advancement, has in this instance to his misfortune declined to exempt him.

6. That when Your Excellency visited the District early in the month of November last and received the Mopla Deputation, Your Excellency were graciously pleased to direct that the memorialist may specially address Your Excellency in Council on this subject and that the matter will be considered over again; that he has accordingly ventured to submit this humble representation in the hope that it will meet with favourable consideration, and that the order, copy of which is attached, may be kindly reconsidered.

7. That he once more humbly begs to submit that he has been found fit physically and qualified in every other respect by both the District Officers (the District Magistrate and the District Superintendent of Police who are the ultimate authorities in Police matters in a District) and the Deputy Inspector General of Police, Southern Range; and he moreover belongs to the most respectable family among the Moplahs—the only things necessary for appointment as a Sub-Inspector.

8. That he at present holds an acting clerk's place in the Taluk Office, Kasaragod, and he trusts that the Tahsildar through whom this memorial is submitted will speak of him as he deserves.

That he in conclusion most humbly and respectfully prays that Your Excellency in Council may, on a kind consideration of the above facts and the encouragement that the memorialist as a Mopla deserves, be graciously pleased to exempt him from the examination rules as a special case and direct his appointment as a Sub-Inspector of Police.

For which act of generosity and kindness he shall, as in duty bound, ever pray.
