Under article 293 of the Civil Account Code, I have the honour to request the renewal of the sanction accorded in G.O., No. 707, Educational, dated 3rd November 1906, for the taking over under departmental management of the Hindu Girls' School at Védaranniyam in the Tanjore district with effect from 1st March 1908. The delay in giving effect to the sanction already accorded is due to the fact that the deed of gift was executed and registered only about the middle of last month.

2. I have also to request that sanction may be accorded to the payment to M.R.Ry. Pichai Pillai from contingencies of the sum of Rs. 5, the registration fee which he had to pay owing to the value of the property not being stated in the deed, and which he says should be borne by Government.

3. The Inspectress recommends that M.R.Ry. Pichai Pillai should also be paid the grant due to the school for the current year. I shall authorize its payment in due course.

4. I enclose the deed of gift for the perusal of Government and safe custody in the Record Office.

Deed of Gift.

THIS INDENTURE made the thirtieth day of November One thousand nine hundred and seven BETWEEN M.R.Ry. NAGAMUTHU PILLAI PICHAI PILLAI, Mirasidar and Pensioned Tahsildar, residing at Védaranniyam, Tirutturaippundi taluk, Tanjore district (hereinafter called "the donor") of the one part and THE RIGHT HONOURABLE THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR INDIA IN COUNCIL (hereinafter called "the donee") of the other part.

WHEREAS the donor is well and sufficiently entitled free from incumbrances to the premises intended to be hereby granted conveyed and assigned and on which the donor has for some time past maintained a school for girls AND WHEREAS the donor has agreed to transfer the said premises to the donee as a gift and the donee has agreed to accept the same AND WHEREAS it has been agreed between the parties hereto that the liability (if any) to payment of stamp duty on these presents shall be discharged by the donee NOW THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH that he the donor doth hereby grant convey and assign unto the donee his successors and assigns ALL THAT piece or parcel of land bearing Survey No. 227-A/5, situated in the village of Védaranniyam in the Taluk of Tirutturaippundi in the Registration Sub-District of Védaranniyam in the Registration district of Tanjore and being more particularly described in the Schedule hereunder written

TOGETHER with the school house and all other buildings if any erected thereon and all furniture and other effects in and about the said school house and other buildings and premises and together also with all trees commons hedges ditches fences ways waters watercourses liberties privileges easements advantages and appurtenances whatsoever to the said piece or parcel of land schoolhouse buildings and premises or any of them in any wise appertaining or heretofore occupied or enjoyed therewith AND all the estate right title interest properly claim and demand whatsoever of the donor into and upon the same premises to HAVE and TO HOLD the said piece or parcel of land messuage and premises hereby granted conveyed and assigned unto the donee his successors and assigns for ever AND the donor doth hereby for himself his executors administrators and representatives covenant with the donee his successors and assigns that he the donor now hath good right to grant convey and assign the premises hereby granted conveyed and assigned unto the donee his successors and assigns in manner aforesaid AND that the donee his successors and assigns shall and may at all times hereafter peaceably and quietly possess and enjoy the said premises without any lawful eviction interruption claim or demand whatsoever from or by the donor his executors administrators or representatives or any other person or persons AND that free from all incumbrances whatsoever AND further that he the donor his executors administrators and representatives and all persons having or lawfully or equitably claiming any estate or interest in the said premises or any of them or any part thereof from under or in trust for the donor his executors administrators or representatives or from or under any of his ancestors shall and will from time to time and at all times hereafter at the request and cost of the donee his successors or assigns do execute and register or cause to be done executed and registered all such acts deeds and things whatsoever for further and more perfectly assuring the said premises and every part thereof unto the donee his successors and assigns in manner aforesaid as shall or may be reasonably required IN WITNESS whereof the donor and the Hon'ble Mr. Alfred Gibbs Bourne, D.Sc., F.R.S., Director of Public Instruction, Madras, acting under the directions of the Governor of Fort St. George in Council for and on behalf of the donee have hereunto set their respective hands and seals the day and year first above written.

[SUBJECT.—*Renewal of sanction to take over under Government management of the Hindu Girls' school at Vedaranniyam.*]

From the Director of Public Instruction, dated 7th February 1908, No. 596.

In G.O., No. 707, Educational, dated 3rd November 1906, the Government sanctioned the taking over under Government management of the Hindu Girls' school at Vedaranniyam in the Tanjore district with effect from 1st March 1907 on the condition that Mr. Pichai Pillai executed a formal deed transferring to Government the school building and furniture absolutely and unconditionally. But as the transfer deed was executed and registered only about the middle of last month, the school has not yet been taken over under Government management. The Director of Public Instruction proposes to take over the school from 1st March next and requests that the sanction accorded in G.O., No. 707, Educational, dated 3rd November 1906, may be renewed, as, under article 293 of the Civil Account Code, the sanction has lapsed, not having been acted on for a year. The Director also requests sanction to the payment of Rs. 5 to Mr. Pichai Pillai on account of the registration fee which he paid to have the transfer deed registered.

2. The Accountant-General states that there is no objection to the renewal of the sanction or to the payment of Rs. 5 to Mr. Pichai Pillai.
