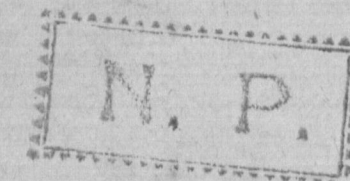

Letter—from A. G. BOURNE, Esq., D.Sc., F.R.S., Director of Public Instruction, Madras.

The Chairman, Municipal Council, Tiruppattūr, applies for a third grant of Rs. 363 towards the cost of extension of the Municipal High school building, and has forwarded the accompanying plan and estimates amounting to Rs. 1,090. In G.O., Mis. No. 2055 M., dated 5th October 1907, Government have approved the Council's proposal to extend the building at a cost of Rs. 1,090, and have indicated the source from which the cost might be met, viz., Rs. 510 which is the estimated closing balance for the current year, and the balance from re-appropriation from other sanctioned allotments in the budget. It would thus appear that no Provincial contribution was promised for the purpose. However, when submitting his remarks in connection with the budget estimate of this Municipality for 1907-1908, Mr. Logan, the Acting Director, proposed a contribution of Rs. 1,000 for the up-keep of the Municipal High school and stated further that the contribution which the Council expected on account of improvements to the high school building might be determined later on on an application being made for it. Please see Director's Endorsement Ref. on Cur. No. 1219/3 of 1906, dated 30th January 1907, read in G.O., No. 690 M., dated 2nd April 1907. In this Government order a sum of Rs. 1,200 was entered as Provincial contribution for education for 1907-1908 and it included Rs. 1,000 for the high school. As the High school is self-supporting and is, therefore, not in need of a contribution for its up-keep, the Chairman was informed with reference to his application under reference that a contribution of Rs. 363 towards the cost of extension of the building would be recommended to Government in lieu of the contribution of Rs. 1,000 for the high school alluded to above. In my letter to Government C. No. 1130, dated 17th February 1908, submitting proposals for the distribution of the Provincial contributions for Municipalities for the current year, I have made mention of this matter and have also stated that the additional allotment requested therein would cover the contribution towards the cost of extension of the Municipal High school building. I have, therefore, the honour to request that payment to the Municipal Council of a contribution of Rs. 363 for the purpose may be sanctioned.

2. As local fund and municipal institutions have been removed from the operation of the Grant-in-Aid Code, the provisions of the Code relating to building grants do not apply to the present case. It seems, therefore, that the contribution recommended above, if sanctioned, may be paid at once even before the completion of the building.

[SUBJECT.—*Requesting sanction to a grant of Rs. 363 towards the cost of extending the
Municipal High school, Tiruppattūr.*]

From the Director of Public Instruction, dated 20th February 1908, No. 8867.

In G.O., No. 2055 M., dated 5th October 1907, the Government approved the proposal of the Municipal Council, Tiruppattūr, to extend the Municipal High school building at a cost of Rs. 1,090. In G.O., No. 690 M., dated 2nd April 1907, reviewing the budget estimate of the Municipality for 1907-1908 a sum of Rs. 1,200 (Rs. 1,000 for Municipal schools + Rs. 200 for the payment of teaching grants) was entered as Provincial contribution for education for 1907-1908.

2. As the high school is self-supporting and is therefore not in need of a contribution for its up keep, the Director of Public Instruction proposes that a contribution of Rs. 363, *i.e.*, one-third of the estimated cost, of the extension of the high school building may be made in lieu of the contribution of Rs. 1,000 for the high school referred to in G.O., No. 690 M., dated 2nd April 1907. Plans and estimates amounting to Rs. 1,090 for the proposed work are also submitted.

3. The funds required for this contribution are included in the additional allotment recently made by the Financial Department under "Contributions to Municipal funds".

4. A draft order sanctioning a contribution of Rs. 363 is submitted for approval.
