Letter—from the Hon'ble Mr. A. G. BOURNE, D.Sc., F.R.S., Director of Public Instruction.

Under article 41 of the Code of Regulations for European Schools, special grants for the following schools have been promised to be paid on submission of the necessary vouchers :—

The promise was made on the presumption that, in the absence of any rule to the contrary, special grants exceeding Rs. 200 could be sanctioned by the Director, without reference to Government. Now, Government in G.O., No. 27, Educational, dated 11th January 1908, have ordered that the limit prescribed in the Grant-in-aid Code in regard to the Director's powers of sanction should be observed in the case of grants under the Code of Regulations for European Schools. As the grants have, on the recommendation of the inspecting officers, been promised already under the circumstances stated above, I have the honour to request the sanction of Government for them to enable me to authorize payment before the close of the current official year on submission of the necessary vouchers which are expected shortly.

2. The grant of Rs. 1,178 promised for St. Bede's European High school, San Thomé, is for the following articles: Furniture, gymnastic apparatus, library books, physical and chemical apparatus and geometrical geographical appliances. The above is a new school recently recognized under the Code of Regulations for European Schools and the articles are needed for its equipment. Hence such a large amount has been promised for it.

3. The above grants can be paid from the current year's allotment of Rs. 6,000.

4. The favour of very early orders is requested.

[SUBJECT.—*Payment of special grants to European Schools.*]

From the Director of Public Instruction, dated 6th March 1908, No. 1663.

Under article 44 of the Code of Regulations for European schools special grants may be sanctioned to schools on the recommendation of the Inspector, but no limit is fixed in the Code as to the sanctioning powers of the Director of Public Instruction.

2. In G.O., No. 27, Educational, dated 11th January 1908, the Government have ruled that the Director of Public Instruction should observe, in regard to his powers of sanction, the limit laid down in article 60 of the Grant-in-Aid Code. Under this article, the Director of Public Instruction can sanction grants up to Rs. 200; and grants exceeding Rs. 200 should be sanctioned by Government.

3. Before the issue of the above order, the Director of Public Instruction had promised the following grants to the schools specified against them:—

These grants were promised on the assumption that special grants exceeding Rs. 200 could be sanctioned by the Director, but their payment has not been authorized yet.

4. The Director of Public Instruction now requests that these grants may now be formally sanctioned by Government to enable him to authorize their payment before the close of the current year on submission of the necessary vouchers.

5. The draft placed below is submitted for approval.

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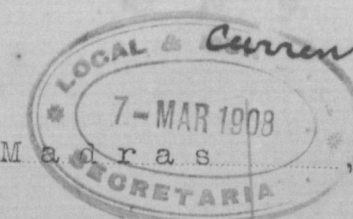
