SUBJECT. Retention of the mason employed in the Reformatory School, Chingleput, for a further period of one year from 1st April 1908.

In G.O. 602 Edddy 13. 9. 06 the Govt. approved the proposal of the D. P. I. to employ a mason in the Reformatory School, Chingleput, ^{for six months} to impart instruction in masonry to the boys of that institution. The mason was actually entertained with effect from the 6th of December 1906. The sanction accorded in G.O. 602 Edddy 13. 9. 06 having expired on 31st March 1907, his retention for a further period of one year, until 31st March 1908, was sanctioned in G.O. 183 Edddy 2. 4. 07.

2. The D. P. I. now states that it is considered desirable to continue the mason for another year and requests that sanction may be accorded to his retention until 31st March 1909.

3. From the account of the working of the class given in Lt. Col. J. C. Marsden's letter R. C. No. 98 d. 15. 4. 07 on pages 10 & 11 of G.O. 336-337 Edddy 3. 6. 07, it will be observed that the pupils take a great interest in the work and are likely to do well and to follow the trade in afterlife. Their progress is also stated to have been satisfactory. From paragraph 2 of D. Bourne's letter on page 2 of G.O. 602 Edddy 13. 9. 06 it is observed that the ^{idea} intention was to try the experiment for a few years. It has now had a trial of only a year and four months nearly.
