With reference to Government Memorandum No. 2962-1, Educational, dated 4th January 1908, I have the honour to submit a draft notification prepared by the Government Solicitor, Madras, for vesting the Ramnad Rani Scholarship Endowment Fund in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments.

2. A separate application signed by me and the Principal, Madura College, Madura, and a separate draft notification prepared by the Government Solicitor for settling a scheme for the administration of the endowment are also herewith submitted for the approval of Government and for publication in the *Fort St. George Gazette*. The Government Solicitor states that he has omitted rule 6 of the rules for the award of the scholarship approved in G.O., No. 783, Educational, dated 26th December 1896, as it would be inconsistent with sections 5 and 6 of the Charitable Endowments Act, 1890, which provide for the modification of any scheme by the Local Government on the application of the persons acting in the administration of the trusts.

IN THE MATTER OF THE CHARITABLE ENDOWMENTS ACT, 1890, AND IN THE MATTER OF THE RAMNAD RANI SCHOLARSHIP FUND.

It is hereby notified that the Governor of Fort St. George in Council, in the exercise of the power conferred by section 4 of the Charitable Endowments Act, 1890, doth hereby order and direct that the securities and moneys now in the hands of the Accountant-General of Madras to the credit of the Ramnad Rani Scholarship Fund and more particularly set forth in the schedule hereto shall as from the date of publication of this notification vest and be thenceforth vested in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments for the territories subject to the Government of Madras and be held by him and his successors (subject to the provisions of the said Charitable Endowments Act, 1890, and to any rules which may from time to time be framed thereunder by the Governor-General of India in Council) upon the trusts for the purposes and subject to the conditions set forth in a scheme under section 5 of the said Charitable Endowments Act, 1890, for the administration of the said Ramnad Rani Scholarship Fund.

IN THE MATTER OF THE CHARITABLE ENDOWMENTS ACT, 1890, AND IN THE MATTER OF THE RAMNAD RANI SCHOLARSHIP FUND.

It is hereby notified that the Governor of Fort St. George in Council, in the exercise of the power conferred by section 5 of the Charitable Endowments Act, 1890, hath settled the scheme set forth in the schedule hereto for the administration of the Ramnad Rani Scholarship Fund and that such scheme shall come into operation on the first day of April 1908.

SCHEDULE.

Scheme.

(1) The Treasurer of Charitable Endowments shall stand possessed of the securities and moneys to the credit of the Ramnad Rani Scholarship Fund (hereinafter referred to as the said fund) upon trust to permit the same to be administered by the Director of Public Instruction for the time being of the Presidency of Madras (hereinafter called the said Director) and the Principal for the time being of Madura College, Madura (hereinafter called the said Principal).

(2) From the interest accruing on the said fund shall be provided a scholarship to be called the Ramnad Rani Scholarship (hereinafter referred to as the said scholarship).

(3) The amount of the said scholarship shall be of the monthly value of Rs. 4-8-0 and shall be paid in each month to the holder of the said scholarship.

(4) The said scholarship shall be awarded to the student of the Madura College who after two years' study in such college shall pass the First Examination in Arts of the Madras University and shall obtain the highest number of marks in Tamil in an open competitive examination to be held by the said Principal among the successful F.A. Undergraduates of the year from the said college.

(5) The said scholarship shall be tenable for two years in any first-grade college connected with the Madras Educational Department and the holder of the said scholarship shall undertake to prosecute his studies up to the B.A. Degree Examination of the University of Madras.

(6) The said scholarship shall be awarded by the said Director and may be suspended or withdrawn at any time by the said Director for irregular attendance, negligence in study or bad conduct.

(7) No student holding any other scholarship shall be eligible for election to the said scholarship.

(8) All interest on the said fund that may not be required for the purpose of the said scholarship shall be accumulated and such accumulations shall from time to time when possible be invested in securities of the Government of India and be added to the principal amount of the said fund.

As the fund cannot be vested in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments unless a notification so vesting the fund is published in the official Gazette, it is submitted that the Director of Public

Instruction may be requested to obtain the draft notification from the Government Solicitor and to submit it to Government at an early date.

From the Director of Public Instruction, dated 20th February 1908, No. 1272.

The Director of Public Instruction submitted with his first letter No. 1272, dated 12th December 1907, an application for vesting the Ramnad Rani scholarship endowment in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments. With his present letter, dated 20th February 1908, he submits a draft notification vesting the fund in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments, and an application for settling a scheme for the administration of the endowment and a draft notification for the purpose. The scheme is a mere reproduction of the rules approved in G.O., No. 783, Educational,

Endowments Act, 1890. The notifications may be published in the Gazette.

Rule 6 of the rules regarding the Ramnad Rani scholarship approved in G.O., No. 783, Educational, dated 26th December 1896, says :—

"It shall be competent to the Director of Public Instruction to modify these rules from time to time with the sanction of the Governor of Fort St. George."

But under sections 5 and 6 of the Charitable Endowments Act, 1890, a scheme for the administration of the trust can be altered by the Local Government only on the application of the persons acting in the administration of the trust, in this case the Director of Public Instruction and the Principal of the Madura College. The above rule has been omitted in the proposed scheme, on the advice of the Government Solicitor, that it would be inconsistent with the provisions of sections 5 and 6 of the Charitable Endowments Act.

2. The scheme appears to be defective in that it does not provide for cases when no candidates come forward for a competition under rule 4. A similar difficulty occurred last year and the Director of Public Instruction's proposal to award the scholarship to a candidate without holding a competitive examination was not accepted by Government—*vide* G.Os., No. 431, Educational, dated 6th July 1907, and No. 645, Educational, dated 30th September 1907. It seems to be desirable to make provision for such cases and it is for consideration whether the Director of Public Instruction A | may be asked to propose an addition to rule 4 to meet such cases.
