Building Grant.

Sanctioning the payment to the St. Thomas' Convent European Girls' school, Madras, of an advance of half the amount of the actual expenditure incurred on the work of repairs to the school buildings.

With reference to G.O., No. 151, Educational, dated 28th February 1908, in connection with the building grant for St. Thomas' Convent European Girls' school, San Thomé, Madras, I have the honour to invite the attention of Government to my letter R.C. No. 8782/6, dated 11th February 1908, in which I stated that only the work of repairs to the building had already been completed and I requested permission to sanction the payment of half of the amount of expenditure incurred on the work of repairs. Government in their order under reference have now sanctioned the payment of the whole grant of Rs. 5,000 on production of a completion certificate from the Public Works Department and subject to the conditions mentioned in paragraph 1 of G.O., No. 72, Educational, dated 28th January 1908. The work of additions to the building has not been completed, permission to begin the work having been given only in January last after the receipt of G.O., No. 72, Educational, dated 28th January 1908. As funds are available, a grant towards the cost of repairs already completed may be paid during the current year on receipt of a completion certificate for that work and the amount so paid may be treated as an advance made out of the whole sanctioned grant of Rs. 5,000 under article 61 of the Code of Regulations for European schools. The balance may be paid after the conditions (2) to (6) specified in paragraph 1 of G.O., No. 72, Educational, dated 28th January 1908, have been satisfied. As the Government Order under reference does not seem to permit the payment, in advance, of a grant for repairs as requested in my letter referred to above, I beg to request that I may be permitted to sanction the payment of the grant of half of the actual expenditure incurred on the work of repairs alone on production of a certificate from the Public Works Department that the work has been satisfactorily carried out in accordance with the approved plan and estimates.

Order—No. 188, Educational, dated 14th March 1908.

Under article 61 of the Code of Regulations for European schools the Government sanction in modification of G.O., No. 151, Educational, dated 28th February 1908, the payment to the St. Thomas' Convent European Girls' school, San Thomé, Madras, of an advance of half the amount of the actual expenditure incurred on the work of repairs to the school buildings, on the production of a certificate from the Public Works Department that the repairs have been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plans and estimates.

NOTES CONNECTED WITH G.O., No. 188, EDUCATIONAL,
DATED 14TH MARCH 1908.

[SUBJECT.—*Requesting permission to pay an advance of half the amount of actual expenditure incurred on the work of repairs to the St. Thomas' Convent European Girls' School, St. Thomé.*]

From the Director of Public Instruction, dated 7th March 1908, No. 8782.

In G.O., No. 72, Educational, dated 28th January 1908, the Government sanctioned a maximum grant of Rs. 5,000 towards the cost of certain improvements and extensions to the building occupied by the St. Thomas' Convent Girls' High school, St. Thomé, subject to the condition, among others, that in the execution of the work the suggestion of the Chief Engineer in regard to the improvements proposed should be adopted.

2. In his letter R.O.C. No. 8782, dated 11th February 1908, on page 1 of G.O., No. 151, Educational, dated 28th February 1908, the Director of Public Instruction reported that as the improvements had already been completed, it was not possible to carry out the suggestions of the Chief Engineer as required by G.O., No. 72, Educational, dated 28th January 1908, and requested that he might be "permitted to sanction payment of half the amount of actual expenditure incurred on the work of repairs on the production of a certificate from the Public Works Department that the repairs have been satisfactorily completed in accordance with the approved plans and estimates, the Chief Engineer's note No. 14 T., dated 22nd January 1908, (read in that order) being left out of account and on the execution of a trust deed and compliance with other conditions stated in the Code."

3. In G.O., No. 151, Educational, dated 28th February 1908, the Government directed, in modification of G.O., No. 72, Educational, dated 28th January 1908, the payment of the whole grant of Rs. 5,000 sanctioned in that order on the production of a certificate from the Public Works Department that the work has been satisfactorily carried out in accordance with the approved plans and estimates.

4. The Director of Public Instruction now points out that the work of additions to the building has not yet been completed and that only the repairs have been completed; and Dr. Bourne requests that he may be permitted to pay half the amount of the actual expenditure on the work of repairs already completed as an advance under article 61 of the Code of Regulations for European schools out of the maximum grant of Rs. 5,000 sanctioned in G.O., No. 72, Educational, dated 28th January 1908, in the current year.

5. It is submitted that the Director's proposal may be accepted. The draft order placed below is submitted for approval.

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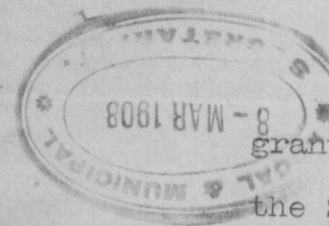
