Krishnaswami Jatavallabar, Personal Assistant to the Director of Public Instruction, to be also Registrar of Books, from 30th October to 18th December 1907, the grant of a local allowance of Rs.150 to him in addition to his sub-pro-tem pay of Rs.200 per mensem requires the sanction of the Government of India.

In G.O. no. 39 Edl dated 17th January 1908 the Govt. appointed M.R. Ry. V. Krishnaswami Jatavallabar, Personal Assistant to the D.P.I., to be also Registrar of Books from 30th October to 18th December 1907, both days inclusive.

2. The D. P. I. now requests sanction of Govt. to the local allowance of Rs 150 per mensem which is attached to the post of Registrar of Books, being drawn by M.R. Ry V. Krishnaswami Jatavallabar for the period from 30th October to 18th December 1907.

3. The A. G. states that the grant of the allowance to M.R. Ry V. Krishnaswami Jatavallabar requires the sanction of the Govt. of India.

4. In G.O. no. 115/6 Edl dated the 14th Feb. 1908, the Govt have already applied for the sanction of the Govt of India to the payment of the allowance to M.R. Ry. M. Rangachariyar from the 19th Dec. 1907. Submitted that in continuation of letter

no 116, Edl, dated 14th Feb. 1908, the Govt of India may be requested to sanction the payment of the allowance of Rs 150 pm to V. Krishna swami Jatavallabhar from 30th October to 18th Dec. 1907.

6. A copy of G.O. no. 115/6 Edl dated 14th Feb. 1908 was available only today.

The allowance of Rs 150 pm is of the nature of a local allowance, and Article 76(i) of the C.S.D. says that "no addition may be made to the pay and allowances of any officer if they exceed or would after the addition exceed Rs 250 a month," without the sanction of the Govt of India. Under this rule, the sanction of India would appear to be necessary for the payment of the allowance to V. Krishna swami Jatavallabhar. If a lump honorarium of Rs 247, were sanctioned instead of a monthly allowance, the sanction of the Local Govt will be enough for the payment - vide Art. 72 of the C.S.D. But this would perhaps be an evasion of the rules. The draft below is for approval. It may be sent to Financial for acceptance.

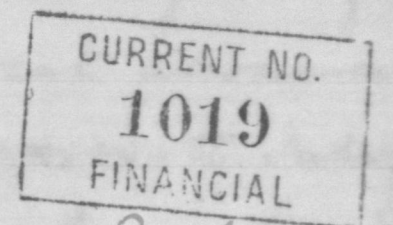

following precedents:-

(1) G.O. No. 31, Ecclesiastical dated
1st May 1907 in which, on the suggestion
of the Acct. Genl, the Rev. C.E. Sell was
granted a lump sum of Rs 100 as
honorarium.

(2) G.O. No. 784, Educational dated
22nd Nov. 1907 in which a lump sum of
Rs 320 was sanctioned as honorarium to
Mr. G. E. Brand from the funds of the
Anjuman-i-Mufid-i-Shi-Islam, for the
period he was in charge of the duties

of the Supt of that institution.
