In G.O. No. 7 Educational dated 7th January 1908,
Government were pleased to sanction the payment of a grant of
Rs 6 per annum per head to the cadets of the Malabar Volunteer
Rifles under instruction in the Santa Cruz High School, Cochin.
On receipt of the above orders, the Correspondent was requested
to submit an application for the grants for 1907-1908 and from
the application received, I find that there are 23 cadets under
instruction in the institution and that all of them have been
certified to be extra efficient for the season 1907-1908. Under
Article 48 of the Code of Regulations for European Schools, for
each extra efficient cadet a grant of Rs 8 may be sanctioned.
In these circumstances, I have the honour to ask whether it is
the intention of Government that a grant of Rs 6 only is to be
given for each of the cadets of this institution which is a non-

Enquiring whether the grant to be paid to the Cadets in the Santa Cruz High School, Cochin should be at the rate of Rs.6 or Rs.8.

V In G.O. No.7 Educational, dated 7th January 1908, the Government sanctioned, in view of the special circumstances of the Santa Cruz High School, Cochin, the payment of a grant of Rs.6 per annum per head to the Cadets of the Malabar Volunteer Rifles under instruction in that institution.

2. The Director of Public Instruction enquires whether it is the intention of Government that a grant of only Rs.6 should be given for each of the Cadets of this institution, which is a non-European School, whether they are efficient or extra efficient.

3. It is submitted that the Director of Public Instruction may be informed that a uniform grant of Rs.6 per head per annum should be given to all Cadets. From the notes with G.O. No.7 Educational dated 7th January 1908, it is observed that it was considered sufficient to pay a grant of Rs.6 and that it was decided that no provision need be made for a higher rate of grant for extra efficient, as in the
