I have the honour to submit that the hostel attached to the Rayapuram Medical School is in charge of a Superintendent for whom special quarters have been provided with reference to G.O., No. 423 W., dated 19th February 1906. The Assistant Superintendent and First Instructor of the school, who is doing the duties of the Superintendent of the hostel, is now occupying them, but as he is a Civil Assistant Surgeon not entitled to free quarters, he has been required to pay a rent of Rs. 20 per mensem, the rate fixed by the Public Works Department for the building occupied by him.

The Hostel Superintendent now requests that he be permitted to live in the quarters free of rent on the ground that he is looking after the hostel business and managing its affairs and that for similar work done in other hostels such a concession is granted. Lieutenant-Colonel Reeves, the Superintendent of the school, strongly recommends the concession applied for.

The supervision and management of the hostel entail a certain amount of trouble and responsibility on the Superintendent for which, in the absence of a special remuneration, some compensation would seem to be expected. The managers, wardens or deputy wardens of other institutions of a similar character are granted either free quarters or a monthly allowance for the work done by them in connection with the hostels under their charge and there does not appear to be any reason why the Superintendent in question should be treated differently. Though an officer of the Medical Department, the Hostel Superintendent is now attached to an educational institution and his case may perhaps be considered as coming within the purview of article 1068 V.B. of the Public Works Code. In these circumstances, I beg to recommend that he be permitted to live in the quarters provided for him rent free in return for the work done by him in connection with the hostel.

NOTES CONNECTED WITH G.O., No. 224, EDUCATIONAL,  
DATED 22ND MARCH 1908.

[SUBJECT.—*Recommending that the Assistant Superintendent of the hostel attached to the Rayapuram Medical school may be allowed to occupy the Superintendent's quarters free of rent.*]

*From the Director of Public Instruction, dated 20th January 1908, No. 7600.*

The Government have provided the hostel attached to the Rayapuram Medical school with quarters for the occupation of the Superintendent of the hostel at a cost of Rs. 4,970—*vide* G.O., No. 423 W., dated 19th February 1906. The duties connected with the hostel are now performed by the Assistant Superintendent and first Instructor of the school and the quarters are occupied by him. But as he is a Civil Assistant Surgeon and as such is not entitled to free quarters, he is now required to pay a rent of Rs. 20 per mensem.

2. The Hostel Superintendent now requests, and both the Superintendent of the school (Lieutenant-Colonel Reeves) and the Director of Public Instruction (Dr. Bourne), recommend that he may be permitted to occupy the quarters free of rent.

3. The Director of Public Instruction points out that the Managers, Wardens or Deputy Wardens of other similar institutions are granted either free quarters or a monthly allowance for the work done by them in connection with the hostels under their charge and that although the present Superintendent of the hostel attached to the Rayapuram school is an officer of the Medical Department still as he is now attached to an educational institution, there is no reason why he should be treated differently from other Superintendents of

\* Present Superintendent's. hostels. The Director of Public Instruction states that "his \* case may, perhaps, be considered as coming within the purview of article 1068-V.B. of the Public Works Code."

4. The conditions as to the grant of free quarters for educational officers, as laid down by the Government of India, will be found detailed in paragraph 3 of Home Department Resolution Nos. 319—331, dated 16th May 1906, on pages 2 and 3 of G.O., No. 392, Educational, dated 15th June 1906. As the supervision and management of the hostel entail a certain amount of trouble and responsibility to the Superintendent, the Director's recommendation may, perhaps, be accepted. Submitted that the remarks of the Public and the Financial Departments may be invited, in the first instance.

P.R.—29-1-08.

The quarters are provided for the Superintendent of the hostel, and any person who does the duties of the Superintendent of the hostel is entitled to the free use of the quarters. The duties of Superintendent of the hostel are now looked after by the Assistant Superintendent of the Medical school (a Civil Assistant Surgeon) and the fact that *as* Civil Assistant Surgeon he is not entitled to free quarters need not, it is submitted, stand in the way of the occupation of the quarters by him, which he gets for doing the duties of Superintendent of the hostel. In this connection, it may be noted that in G.O., No. 747, Educational, dated 9th November 1907, the Government sanctioned the acceptance by the Deputy Warden of the Victoria Hostel, Madras, of a remuneration of Rs. 50 per mensem in lieu of quarters.

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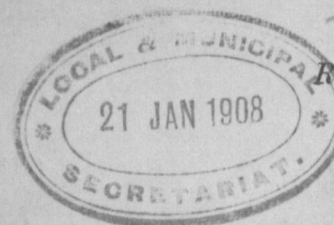
