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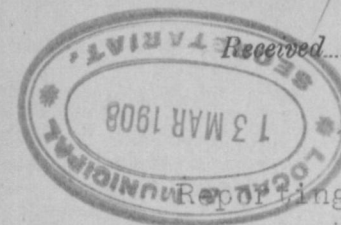

In G.O. no. 232 Edl dated 29th March 1906 the Govt sanctioned a grant of Rs 22,000 towards the cost of constructing additional buildings for the St Aloysius' High School, Vizagapatam, and stated that by the time the work was completed, separate accommodation should be provided for the native children in the school - vide clause (5) of para-1 of G.O. no. 232 Edl. dated 29th March 1906.

2. In G.O. no. 125 Edl dated, the Govt sanctioned the payment of an advance out of the grant sanctioned for the school and requested the D.P.I. to report what action had been taken by the management to provide separate accommodation for the native children attending the school, with ref to Clause 5 of para-1 of G.O. no. 232 Edl & 29-3-06.

3. The D.P.I. reports that separate study and dining rooms, dormitory and playground in a separate compound have been provided for native children since June 1906 and that at the same time the percentage of non-Europeans in the school was brought down to less than 15 per cent - article 7 (d) of the Code of Regulations for

European Schools.
