With reference to paragraph 2 of G.O. No. 690 Mis d/
10th October 1907, I have the honour to report that the cost of
periodicals supplied to the Kumbakonam College and the Arts
College, Rajahmundry, is covered by the fees levied from students
in the respective colleges.

2. As regards the Training College, Rajahmundry, I beg
to report that no fees are levied from students on that account
on the analogy of the Teachers' College which receives its
supply of periodicals free under G.O. No. 767 Educational dated
15th December 1902 and to recommend that the same privilege of
free supply of periodicals be extended ~~to~~ to the Training
College, Rajahmundry.

Free Supply of periodicals to the Govt.
Training College, Rajahmundry.

In G.O. no. 690 Edl. dated 10th October 1907 the Govt. sanctioned the supply of certain periodicals to the Govt. ^{Arts} Colleges at Hambakonam and Rajahmundry and the Govt Training College at Rajahmundry, in the place of certain other periodicals ordered to be discontinued and observed that it was assumed that the cost of the periodicals would be covered by the fees recovered from the students in each case.

2. With reference to this remark the D.P.I. now reports that the cost of the periodicals supplied to the Hambakonam and Rajahmundry ^{Arts} Colleges is covered by the fees levied from the students of those colleges, but that in the Training College at Rajahmundry no fees are levied from the students on the analogy of the Teachers' College ^{at Sardapat} which receives its supply of periodicals free under G.O. no. 767 Edl dated 15th Dec-1902. The Director recommends that the privilege of free supply of periodicals now enjoyed by the Teachers' College may be extended to the Rajahmundry Training College.
