One of the subjects of examination for the Civil Judicial Test is the Code of Civil Procedure, which has now been revised, the revised Code having received the assent of His Excellency the Viceroy about a fortnight ago. I have the honour to enquire, with reference to article 7 of the Special Test Notification, whether candidates at the next Special Test Examinations to be held in October 1908 are to be examined on the Code now in force or on the revised Code which will not come into operation till 1st January 1909. I think the former course would be advisable.
