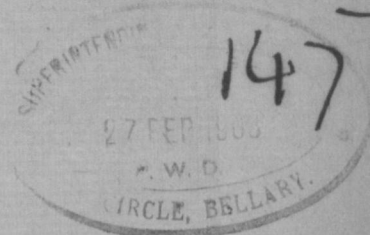

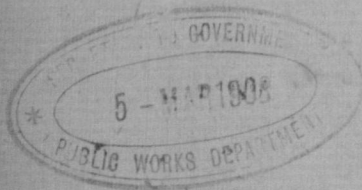

The Executive Engineer, J. R. S. Division, recommends the exemption of N. Ramachandra Aiyar from the examination prescribed for the Sub-overseer & Surveyor class of the College of Engineering for appointment as a temporary Sub-overseer on Rs 35. p. m. for one year. It is stated that by the end of this period passed men will be secured.

3. If passed Candidates are not to be entertained on the ground that they are new, it is not clear how the Executive Engineer will be able to secure the services of qualified men even at the end ^{of} one year, the period for which exemption is now sought.

4. It is for consideration whether the exemption may be granted for one year as recommended. ~~Perhaps the P.W.D. may be requested to say whether exemption for a short period, say, three months will not do.~~
