In their order No. 3190, Revenue, dated 30th December
1907, Government were pleased to sanction the provincialisation
of the office establishment of the Court of Wards. In giving
effect to this order, the Board finds that two of the old clerks
(mentioned below) on that establishment have not passed some of

the

the tests prescribed for the Government Service. Similar cases arose when the Local Fund Account Establishments were provincialised -- please see the Board's Reference No. 39, dated 19th March 1907, disposed of

No. (1) M.R.Ry. D. Mariapragasa Udayar has passed the First Examination in Arts and has put in a service of over 19 years in the Court's Office. When he entered the Court's Service, men who had passed the First Examination in Arts were not required to pass the Hand-Writing and Dictation Test. He did not appear for the Precise-Writing and Translation Tests, as they have not been required hitherto for appointments in the Court's Office. No. (2) K. Subba Rao has passed the Matriculation Examination and has put in a service of over 4 years in the Court's Office. He is a useful clerk and has acquired considerable experience of ^{the} routine work of the office. The Court considers it desirable to retain him rather than replace him by an unpractised man. He also knows *how*

to type-write.

2. The Board therefore requests that Government will be pleased to exempt the two clerks from passing the tests noted against their names.

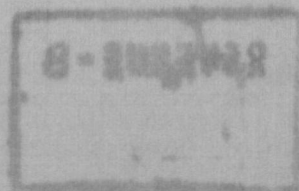
