SUBJECT Exemption from the examination rules of Mr. J. G. Thompson for appointment as an Inspector of Police in the Malabar Dt.

The J. G. of Police recommends the permanent exemption from the Precis Writing and the Criminal Judicial (Lower) tests of Mr. Thompson for employment as an Inspector of Police on a Salary of Rs 70-Rs 200 per mensem. It is proposed to give him Rs 100 to start with. From Cols 8 & 9 on page 2 of Current file it is observed, "the applicant is a permanent Sergeant in the Malabar Dt on Rs 80 p. m. He is now in charge of an Inspector's division and has proved his fitness for Inspector's work. He is an Eurasian with a thorough knowledge of Malayalam. Men of his stamp are much needed in the department."

2. Attention is solicited to the Hon'ble Mr. Forbes' remarks on page 8 of Gou. 56 Redl dy 21-1-08 :-

"We can't get the appropriate proportion of Europeans and Eurasian Candidates without, I fear, some exemptions."

3. It is for consideration whether the J.G.'s recommendation may be accepted. Perhaps the remarks of the Judicial department may be invited also.
