Subject.

Admission of a pupil into the Civil Orphan Asylum
on the foundation of the Waltair Orphanage.

The Honorary Secretary of the Civil Orphan
Asylums requests, on behalf of the Directorate,
the sanction of Government for the admission of
Theodora Chapman, a female Orphan from Ellore,
on the foundation of the Waltair Orphanage.

2. In 1894 the Government sanctioned the
abolition of the Waltair Orphanage, and ordered
its buildings to be sold and undertook to main-
tain from the amount realized by the sale of
the buildings the boys and girls who were then
in the Orphanage until they arrived at an age
to earn their own living. The Orphanage was
closed accordingly and thirteen pupils from it
were sent to the Civil Orphan Asylum, the Govern-
ment agreeing to pay Rs.15 per mensem for the
maintenance of each ^{pupil} - Vide G.O. No.482 Edl.,
dated 29th June 1894.

3. Subsequently in 1902, as there was a
sufficient balance of the funds belonging to
the Waltair Orphanage, the Government sanctioned
the admission of ~~one~~ ^{three} new Orphans from the
Northern Circars into the Civil Orphan Asylums
and

and paid Rs.15^{each} per mensem for their maintenance.
 Vide G.O. No.117 Educational, dated 5th March 1902, G.O.No.268 Educational dated 6th May 1902 and G.O. No.742 Educational dated 5th December 1902. But owing to the insufficiency of the funds belonging to the Waltair Orphanage the Government refused to sanction further admissions. Please see G.O. No.621 Educational dated 11th October 1904 and G.O.No.604 Educational dated 8th September 1905.

4. There are now in the Civil Orphan Asylum only two orphans belonging to the Waltair Foundation, namely, William Tremenheere and Charlotte Latimer and these will continue until they attain 17 years of age, that is, until September 1909 and July 1909, respectively.

5. The balance to the credit of the Waltair Orphanage on the 31st March 1907 was only Rs.533-8-5. Of this sum, Rs.360 would have been expended in 1907-08 and the balance available namely, Rs.173-8-5 ^{will} hardly suffice ~~to~~ to meet the cost of maintenance of the two orphans till they leave the Asylum in 1909.

6. It is therefore submitted that the Directors of the Civil Orphan Asylum may be informed that owing to insufficiency of the funds belonging to the Waltair Orphanage, the Government are unable to sanction the admission of Theodora Chapman into the ~~Civil Orphan~~ Asylum on the foundation of the Waltair Orphanage.

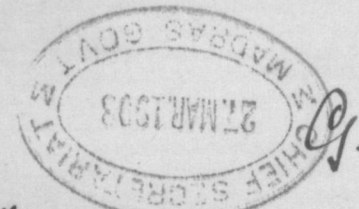

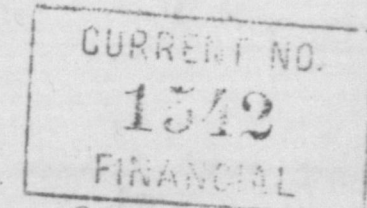
