I have the honour to request under article 72 (a) and (b) of the Civil Service Regulations, the sanction of Government to the payment to the undermentioned officers of the remuneration for which they have become eligible for the work done by them in connection with the Preliminary examination for Teachers' certificates held in December 1907:—

2. The remuneration due to the remaining members who took part in the examination will be sanctioned by me as the amount due in each case is less than Rs. 100. The remuneration has been calculated on the scale adopted in previous years.

3. The total fee receipts of the examination amounted to Rs. 1,884 and the total remuneration proposed to be given to the examiners including the four mentioned in paragraph 1 above amounts to Rs. 1,887. There is a provision of Rs. 6,300 in the current year's budget for "Remuneration for Teachers' Certificate Examiners" from which the charges on account of this examination can be met.

Under rule 141 of the Educational rules it is the duty of the Inspector of Training Schools and the staffs of the Training institutions to conduct the Preliminary examination for Teachers' certificates. [SUBJECT.—*Payment of remuneration to Educational officers who conducted the Preliminary Examination for Teachers' Certificates.*]

From the Director of Public Instruction, dated 25th March 1908, No. 1834.

The Director of Public Instruction requests the sanction of Government to the payment of remuneration to the undermentioned Educational officers for work done by them in connection with the preliminary examination for Teachers' certificates:—

2. In the case of the Scholarships examinations held under the Code of Regulations for European Schools, the Government have held that no remuneration should be paid to the officers of the Educational Department who assisted in the conduct of those examinations, as the conduct of the examinations should be regarded as forming part of the regular duties of those officers.

3. It is for consideration whether the ruling may be applied to the Preliminary examination for Teachers' certificates also and remuneration refused to the officers of the Educational Department.

The total receipts from fees for this examination amounted to Rs. 1,884, and the total remuneration proposed to the examiners including the four specified in the current letter to Rs. 1,887.

If Government refuse fees in one case, they should do it in all cases in which the examination is purely departmental.

C. A. SOUTER—28-3-08.

I should like to know more about this examination, what it qualifies for and who are admitted to it. If it is restricted to persons studying in Government Training Colleges and Schools, then the examination work should be distributed amongst those who are on the staff of the various Training institutions without additional remuneration. But if it is an open examination I do not see why payment should not be made,

if the amounts are within the limit of the fee income realised, which is the case here. Examinations for the grant of Government scholarships may be on quite a different footing. Do these Teachers' Certificate examination fall under the head of Technical examinations?

H. D. TAYLOR—29-3-08.

The examinations for Teachers' certificates do not fall under the head of "Technical examinations". These examinations appear to come under the class of "Departmental examinations".

Rule 140 of the Educational Rules, 1906 Edition. 2. Teachers' Certificates examination are of three grades, namely:—

- (1) Collegiate,
- (2) Secondary, and
- (3) Elementary.

3. The examination for the Collegiate certificate is the L.T. Degree examination of the University. For the Secondary and Elementary certificates, the examination is divided into two parts, a Preliminary examination, which is conducted by the Inspector of Training Schools with the assistance of the staffs of the Training Schools and such other persons as the Director may, from time to time, depute for the purpose; and a final examination conducted by a Board.

4. The examinations for Secondary and Elementary Teachers' certificates are open only to candidates who have passed through the prescribed course of training in a recognized Secondary or Elementary Training institution or department; but candidates who failed in one examination may be allowed to appear at a subsequent examination without further attendance at a training school.
