Sir,

The Secretary to the Commissioner for Government Examinations, Madras, has intimated to my Personal Assistant that, to meet an actual requirement of 60 Native Military Pupils this year - 10 for Madras and 50 for Bengal or Bombay as advertised in the Fort Saint George Gazette - he has received only 3 applications from candidates qualified under Rule 4 of the "Rules and Regulations for the training of Hospital Assistants" appended to G.O., No. 721, Educational, dated the 30th October 1907. It has therefore become necessary to temporarily lower the standard of the Educational qualifications in this case - I have therefore the honor to request the sanction of Government, with reference to Rule 5 of the above quoted Rules and Regulations

to

to the standard of the Educational qualifications being temporarily lowered in the case of Native Military Pupils so as to allow of those who produce evidence of having studied in the 4th, 5th or 6th Form being admitted this year to the Competitive Examination.

2. As the 15th May 1908 has been fixed as the date for holding the Competitive Examination, I solicit the favor of very early orders being passed on the subject.

Under rule 4 of the rules approved in G.O. no. 721 Edl dated 30th October 1907 only candidates who have passed the matriculation examination or the compulsory portion of the upper secondary examination are eligible for admission to the native military pupils class. ^{But} ~~and~~ under rule 5 if a sufficient number of qualified candidates are not available in any one year, the standard of educational qualifications may be temporarily lowered with the special sanction of Govt.

2. The Surgeon General now reports that for 60 vacancies in the native military pupils' grade - 10 for Madras and 50 for Bengal & Bombay only 3 candidates qualified under rule 4 have applied and ^{he} requests the sanction of Govt to lowering ~~the~~ ^{the} standard of educational qualifications ^{prescribed in that rule} so as to allow of those who

produce evidence of having studied in the W, V or VI form being admitted this year to the competitive examination.
