Exemption of Mr. H. R. Grant from the Matriculation Exams for enlistment as a Sub-Inspector of Police.

The I. G. of Police (Mr. Cowie) recommends that Mr. H. R. Grant, son of a Loco-Inspector, South Indian Railway may be exempted from the Matriculation Examination for enlistment as a Sub-Inspector of Police.

2. The candidate is a ^{19 years old} European and is at present employed as a Sub-Inspector in the Engineering Department of the South Indian Ry. Company. He has not passed any examination but was for about 8 years at School.

3. Mr. Cowie says that he has interviewed the candidate and is pleased with his manners and address. He ~~also~~ adds ~~that~~ "we are in want of Europeans as Sub Inspectors and Inspectors" and that "it is by no means easy to recruit them."

4. Attention is invited to the notes connected with G.O. No. 56 Educational dated 21st Jan 1908 granting exemption in ^{an} exactly similar case in dealing with which the Honble Mr. Fortes noted as follows:—
