I have the honour to submit for favourable consideration an application for permanent exemption from the examination rules on behalf of one Behara Appala Narsimhulu Patnaik sub protom 4th clerk of the Special Assistant Agent's Office, Balli-guda division.

2. The candidate is an Uriya Patnaik and passed the late Middle School Examination. He holds a permanent appointment of Rs. 20 in the Agency and has put in a service of 10 years in the Agency tracts. He now requests that he may be permanently exempted from the examination rules so as to enable him to get any appointment of Rs. 20 in the plains as his health has been greatly shattered during the 10 years' service in the Agency.

3. The Special Assistant Agent under whom he has been working recommends strongly his transfer to the plains and his exemption from the examination rules to hold a post of Rs. 20 in the plains.
