SIR,

We have the honour to invite a reference to the correspondence ending with your despatch no. 194-Public, dated the 6th December 1907, in which you approved of the appointment of Mr. F. E. Morgan, of the Public Works Department, to act as Professor of Mechanical Engineering in the College of Engineering, Madras, pending the arrival from England of Mr. Cartwright, the newly selected candidate for the post.

2. The Government of Madras now report that Mr. Cartwright assumed charge of his duties on the 13th November 1907, and that they have, in anticipation of sanction, retained Mr. Morgan's services temporarily, on the terms already approved, for the professorship of civil engineering which had meanwhile fallen vacant in the same college. They say that they have received no intimation of the probable date of arrival of the candidate whom you have been asked to select for the post, and that it is necessary to secure continuity in the college classes. We have confirmed the local Government's action, and we trust that our proceedings will meet with your approval.
