From the Government of India, dated 24th April 1908, No. 872.

In their Resolution No. 11, Public/790-801, dated the 24th April 1891, printed with G.O., No. 376, Public, dated 12th May 1891, the Government of India fixed the 15th of March as the latest date for the submission to them of the report on publications registered under Act XXV of 1867.

2. This Government thereupon fixed the 1st of March as the date on which the report should be submitted to them by the Director of Public Instruction—vide G.O., No. 264, Educational, dated 23rd March 1892.

3. The Government of India are now pleased to alter the date from 15th of March to 15th of June. The date of submission of the report to this Government may accordingly be altered from the 1st of March to the 1st of May, so that there may be sufficient time for the report to be printed and despatched to India by the 15th June.
