I have the honour to submit a copy of an application for an endowment grant received from the Secretary to the Venkatarayudu Memorial Scholarship endowment instituted in connection with the Rajahmundry Training College.

2. It appears to me that there is no pressing necessity for the larger sum now asked for as grant. All the available funds for grants-in-aid are urgently required for other purposes.

3. In the meantime, I am taking steps for having a revised scheme drawn up for the administration of the endowment as suggested in Government Memorandum No. 174-1, Educational, dated 6th February 1908, on the assumption that no grant will be given under the Grant-in-Aid Code.

With reference to the Director's Proceedings Ref. on Cur. No. 8398/06, dated 4th March 1908, accepting the endowment of Rs. 1,100 for Venkatarayudu Memorial Scholarship, I have the honour to invite your attention to chapter X of the Grant-in-Aid Code and to request you will be pleased to obtain a grant of Rs. 550 towards the endowment.

2. The endowment created is entirely from private funds. The trust deed required under article 62 (iii) will be executed by the Trustees according to the conditions laid down therein.

3. The scholarship is intended to help the poor of a really educationally backward class of the Merakavedhi Telaga community and the grant given by the Government will fetch an additional income of Rs. 19½ by which we may be in a position either to increase the rate of the present scholarship or to create another scholarship in lower classes, as may be suggested by you.

Please see G.O., No. 781, Educational, dated 1st December 1906. In that order, the Government accepted the offer of the Sub-Committee, Venkatarayudu Memorial Fund, to endow a scholarship in connection with the Training College at Rajahmundry and requested the Director of Public Instruction to obtain a formal application for vesting the endowment* in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments and for settling a scheme for its administration.

2. An application for vesting the endowment in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments has been received but the scheme for its administration has not been settled and the matter is still under consideration. Please see Memorandum No. 174-1, dated 6th February 1908.

3. Meanwhile, the Sub-Committee, Venkatarayudu Memorial Fund, has applied for a half grant of Rs. 550 for the endowment under article 61 of the Grant-in-Aid Code. The Director of Public Instruction in submitting the application states that there is no pressing necessity for the grant asked for and that all the available funds for Grants-in-Aid are urgently required for other purposes.

4. It is for consideration whether the grant applied for may be refused in the circumstances explained by the Director of Public Instruction. For a precedent for sanctioning a grant in similar cases, please see G.O., No. 630, Educational, dated 1st November 1901, and also G.O., No. 130, Educational, dated 4th March 1899.

The grant is applied for to supplement the endowment of Rs. 1,100 already invested in Government securities and is intended to increase the amount of the scholarship which could be awarded from the interest accruing on the endowment or to create another scholarship in the lower classes. The endowment has not yet been vested in the Treasurer of Charitable Endowments and if any grant is to be given at all, it seems to be desirable that it is given immediately so that a vesting order and a scheme for the entire amount (including the grant) may be issued once for all. The Director of Public Instruction however considers that there is no "pressing necessity" for the grant asked for and states that he is preparing the draft scheme of administration on the assumption that no grant is to be given under the Grant-in-Aid Code.
