Sir,

I have the honour to recommend for the favourable -- consideration of Government the request of 2 Matriculates in this district for permission to appear for the Criminal Lower Judicial Test. While I am loth to trouble --- Government for any such concessions, I venture to make an exception in the case of these 2 persons, who are -- reported by their Divisional Officers Mr. Wait and Mr. Braidwood to be the best Matriculates in their respective divisions. One of them is a non Brahmin. My own --- opinion about Matriculates is that they take far more willingly to the drudgery of a Taluk office than Graduates and that when they show conspicuous merit, it is desirable to give them full encouragement. In this district the Brahmin element preponderates: and it is an advantage to have an infusion of non Brahmins in public offices.

3. The 2 persons I recommend are (1) M. Ganapathirao 4th English Clerk on Rs. 30 in my office and Acting Revenue Inspector in Ramachendrapur Taluk (2) C.V. Subbarao, Head Gumasta, Rajahmundry Taluk Office and Acting 3rd clerk on Rs. 30 in the Sub Collectors Office. Both have passed Revenue Test (Lower) Account Test (Lower) Precise writing and Translation Lower. Ganapathi Rao had worked for -- ^{seven years} ~~eight years~~ in the Agency tracts and was lately transferred to the Plains. While in the Agency he served with great satisfaction under Mr. Woodhouse and Mr. Waite. Mr. -- Waite has expressed a very high opinion of him: and it would be an appropriate act to let him have an opportunity of appearing for Criminal Lower. He is ^aman of good - physique and well qualified to be Sub Magistrate in the

Agency. He is as already stated a non-Brahmin.

3. C.V. Subbarao although a Brahmin, is so well spoken by Mr. Braidwood that I venture to send up his name also. Mr. Braidwood writes of him as follows:- "Petitioner is the best clerk of his standing in the Division. He knows his work thoroughly. His work and conduct have been quite satisfactory during the ^{3 1/2} years during which I have known him. He is one of the best matriculates I have known and deserves exemption, if such exemptions are ever granted to those who do not belong to backward castes."

NOTES.

C.No. 919 From the Collector of Godavari No. 815 Rev. dated 9. 4. 1908.

SUBJECT. Recommending that two clerks may be permitted to appear for Criminal Judicial test, Lower Grade.

Of the two persons (M. Ganapathi Rao and C. V. Subbarao) on whose behalf permission to appear for the criminal judicial test, Lower grade, is now recommended by the Collector of Godavari (Mr. J. J. Cotton) Ganapathi Rao is said to have worked for seven years in the Agency tracts. The Collector states that it would therefore be an appropriate act to let him have an opportunity of appearing for Criminal Lower. But the recommendation on behalf of C. V. Subbarao appears to have been made purely on personal grounds.

2. The Govt. ^{have in the past} show some concession to those who have served in the Agency tracts - e.g. - please see G.O. 246 Edldy 26 April 1907 and 453 Edldy 16. 7. 07. It is for consideration whether the two candidates may be permitted to appear for the Criminal Judicial test, Lower Grade, and if so how many chances ^{should} ~~may~~ be allowed. Ordinarily such permission is restricted to one or two years.

3. The Revenue department may, perhaps, be consulted as to the desirability of complying with the Collector's request in the matter no.

As for Cynapatt Rao, if he has any claim at all, it is only that he may in the future make a good Agency Dy. Tahaddas. Lubba Rao is only the best clerk of his standing in the sub-division. This may mean little or nothing.
