The total amount of honoraria to be dis-
bursed is Rs.631, after making a reduction of
25 per cent. as required in G.O. No.481, Edl.,
dated 16th July 1906. The fee receipts amounted
to Rs.464 or Rs.167 less than the proposed hono-
raria.

2. Under Article 72(b) of the Civil Ser-
vice Regulations the Local Government is com-
petent to sanction the honoraria as they do not
exceed Rs.500 in the case of each individual.
Attention is, however, solicited to the orders
with G.O. No.719, Edl., dated 29th October 1907,
from which it is observed that in connection with
the payment of remuneration to the Examiners who
assisted in the Technical Examinations of
April 1907, certain further reductions were
made in the honoraria, so as to bring them down
to the total receipts from fees. Orders are
solicited whether similar reduction should be
made in the honoraria now proposed. If a
proportionate reduction is to be made, then the
honoraria will stand as follows:--
