2. I entered the Revenue Department
in 1901 and have since then put in
a Continuous Service of 5 years. I
am well acquainted with the routine
work of this Department. I have
passed the Lower Secondary Examination
& studied up to the Matriculation.
In the year 1905 the Government was
pleased to exempt me from the Examination
Rules and I was permitted to draw
a salary of Rs 20 excluding the Hill
allowance

3. The grade of 15 Rs in this District
having since been abolished in G. O.
No. 202 of 1907 any new man newly joining
the Department, is entitled to draw a
pay of Rs 20 + 5 (H. R.). In consideration
of my long service I beg to request

that now will be pleased to recommend
me for an exemption ^{either} from promotion or
to appear for the special test Examination
so that I may qualify myself for
promotion.

Recommending the permanent exemption from the Upper Secondary Examination of Sevanah Gowden, Head Clerk, Stationery Sub-Magistrate's Office, Coonoor.

Sevanah Gowden was exempted from the examination rules in G.O.No.112, Edl., dated 21st February 1905 for employment in the Nilgiri Collectorate on pay not exceeding Rs20 per mensem.

2. Sevanah Gowden is now acting Head Clerk of the Stationery Sub-Magistrate's ^{Office} at Coonoor on Rs20, exclusive of local allowance. He states that under G.O.No.212, Revenue, dated 24th January 1908, the lowest pay of clerks in the ^{Collectorate of the} Nilgiris has been fixed at Rs20 exclusive of local allowance and that he is therefore drawing the same pay with all new comers. He therefore requests that he may be further exempted from the examination rules for promotion to posts carrying higher pay than Rs20 or be permitted to appear for the special tests so that he may qualify himself for promotion.

3. The Stationary Sub-Magistrate supports the application of Sevanah Gowden and recommends that as the Badagas of the Nilgiris require to be encouraged, Sevanah Gowden who is a Badaga may be permitted to appear for the Revenue (Lower), the Precise Writing and the Translation tests.

4. The Revenue Divisional Officer (Mr. Leigh) states that Sevanak is a useful office hand.

5. The Collector of the Nilgiris (Mr. Robertson) recommends that Sevanak may be exempted from the examination rules for employment in any post on pay not exceeding Rs.30 per mensem. The grounds on which the Collector bases his recommendation are (1) that it is desirable to encourage the Badagas and (2) that passed candidates do not remain long on the Nilgiris.

6. It is for consideration whether the Collector's recommendation may be accepted.

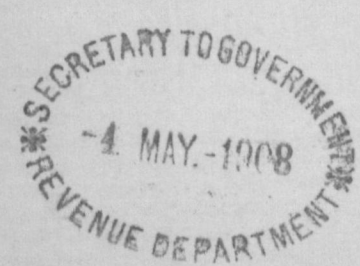

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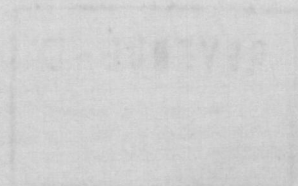
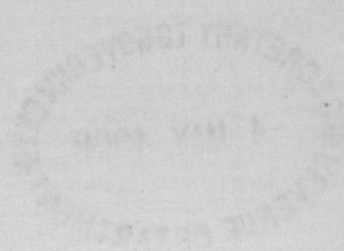
