He has passed the Precis writing and Translation Test ---- Lower. He has put in 18 years service in the Forest Branch of my office having acted as Accountant for more than 13 years. He has a thorough knowledge of all branches of office work including accounts and is quite competent to be confirmed as Head Clerk. He has been well spoken of by all the District Forest Officers under whom he served. As he has passed only the Middle School Examination in the 1st Class he is debarred from appearing for any special tests. As, according to the Notification mentioned above, it is necessary for him to pass the Account Test (Lower). I have the honour to request that the Government may be pleased to allow him two years time, that is till 1910, to pass the Test by exempting him from Examination Rules, in consideration of his long and approved service.

Requesting Government to exempt C. Balakrishnachari, sub pro tem Head Clerk, District Forest Office, Ganjam, from passing the Account Test, Lower grade, until the results of the examination to be held in October 1909 are published and permit him to appear for the examination.

According to the Special Test Notification as modified with reference to H.O.No.111, Educational, dated 12th February 1908, the Account test, lower grade, is one of the special tests prescribed for the post of Head Clerk in District Forest Offices.

2. The Collector of Ganjam (Mr. Partridge) recommends that C. Balakrishnachari, sub pro tem Head Clerk of the Forest Branch of his office, who is not so qualified, may be exempted from passing the test for two years.

3. The candidate has passed the ~~Precis~~ ^{test} Writing and the Translation test, Lower grade, has put in 18 years' service, and is well spoken of by the District Forest Officers under whom he had served. But as he has passed only the Middle School Examination in the 1st class, he cannot, under Article 4 of the Special Test Notification, appear for the Account test, Lower grade. XX ^{therefore} The Collector requests that the candidate may be permitted to appear for this test in consideration of his long and approved service.
