Letter No. 146 S.E., dated 14-3-08, from the Executive Engineer, Ganjam Division.

10/ In submitting herewith a special application for the permanent exemption from Examination Rules of Shaik Faizuddin temporary clerk on Rs. 15/- in this office, as called for by you in your Memo. No. 70 G.J., dated 31st January 1908, I beg to report as follows:-

1. This clerk is a Mahammadan, a class which is comparatively backward in the matter of education and of employment in Government service and therefore deserving of special consideration.

2. He has studied up to the old Middle school class and possesses a fair knowledge of English, enough to get through the work required of him. He writes a good hand and is both intelligent and hardworking.

3. His first entertainment in Government service as a temporary clerk was in the year 1893 and he has been continuously in employ since that date, thereby putting in a total service of about 15 years in all. The major part of his service was spent by him as a section clerk and now for the last two years and a half, he has been tried in the Divisional Office both in the correspondence and the Accounts sections and found a very useful hand.

4. His age is about 34 years and he is a well behaved. In my opinion a man of this stamp is far more useful than any of the raw matriculates seeking to enter the service. Further I have personally found it, so far, extremely difficult, nay impossible, to procure passed candidates in this

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District and especially, the clerical establishment of the Public Works Department here, seems to offer no inducement to passed men from outside the District. All the temporary acting and sub-pro-tem clerkships on Rs.15/- in this Division are now filled by unpassed men excepting one which is held by a passed man, whose qualifications and abilities however, are, in my opinion, inferior to those of Shaik Faizuddin for whom exemption is now solicited.

5. While fully realising the force and spirit of the principles laid down by Government in G.O.No. 570 Educational dated 18th August 1905 (communicated with your No. 1335 G.L. dated 2nd October 1905) and in Chief Engineer's Memos. Nos. 4790-C, dated 9th October 1907 and 484-D, dated 6th June 1906, I beg most prominently to bring to your notice the necessity for treating the case of this clerk specially for the reasons set forth in detail above.

6. Under the circumstances, I request that you will be pleased to recommend to Government to sanction the permanent exemption of the clerk from Examination Rules so as to admit of his holding appointments in the superior Government service, up to a limit of Rs. 30/-.
