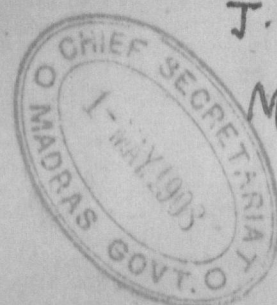
2. A draft order accepting the Dy. G's recommendation is submitted. If approved, it may issue with the Concurrence of the Judicial Department.

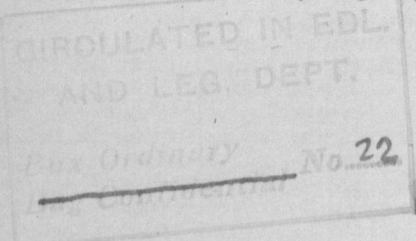
