He ~~appears~~ requests that he may be permitted to appear for the Criminal Judicial Test, Lower Grade, as he is anxious to better his prospects in that State -

2. There appears to be no reason for granting the request. The Peti. is not a servant of this Govt but of the native State of Cochin.
