[SUBJECT.—Retention of the temporary establishment of the School of Arts.]

G.O., No. 155, Educational, dated 3rd March 1908.

From the Director of Public Instruction, dated 9th May 1908, No. 3157.

In G.O., No. 155, Educational, dated the 3rd March 1908, the Government sanctioned the retention of the temporary establishment of the School of Arts up to the 31st May 1908. It was then hoped that the reorganization of the school would be sanctioned by the 31st May 1908.

2. The reorganization of the School of Arts has not yet been sanctioned.

* The file is now with His Excellency the Governor, having been submitted to him on 11th May 1908.

Proposals for the reorganization were only recently received and they are now under the consideration of Government *. It cannot be said with certainty when they will be sanctioned.

3. The Director of Public Instruction now requests that sanction may be accorded to the retention of the temporary establishment until the reorganization of the school is sanctioned. Submitted that sanction may be accorded to the retention of the establishment until the 31st July 1908 or until the reorganization of the school, whichever is earlier.

4. The draft order placed below is submitted for approval. If approved, it may be sent to the Financial Department for acceptance.

The file relating to the reorganization of the School of Arts is now in circulation with His Excellency † the Governor. The proposals made are general; but as regards

the staff of the school, they are as far as possible complete, except that provision for the Assistant Superintendent has been omitted. On the issue of orders approving the proposals, a proposition statement will have to be submitted by the Director of Public Instruction for the sanction of Government. The draft submitted seems sufficient and may be approved.

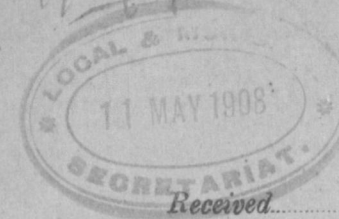
