The cost of the message was Rs 4-6-0. ~~and~~ The A.G. has disallowed the charge on the ground that the Supdt. is not authorized to send foreign State telegrams and requests that the sanction of the Govt of India may be obtained to the expenditure. I am to request that in the special circumstances of the case the Govt. of India will be pleased to sanction the expenditure.
