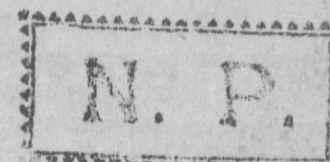

ABSTRACT.—Declining to permit the construction of a hostel and residential quarters for the Hostel Superintendent attached to the Pittapur Raja's College, Cocanada, in anticipation of approval to plans and estimates.

With reference to Ref. on Cur. No. 3404-A/07, dated 31st January 1908, I have the honour to return herewith the plans and the estimates with the position of the stair-case shown in the plan. Provision was made in the estimate for the stair-case.

2. When this application was submitted about nine months ago, I stated that the hostel meant for 24 had been made to accommodate 32. Now the number is about 44 and a few more are expected; the present strength of the college classes being about 120. Some students are lodging here and there for want of accommodation. Thus several students are being put to very great hardship. I beg, therefore, very earnestly to request that I may be early favoured with orders to start work. For the actual payment of the sanctioned amount of grant, I shall wait till next official year, if the plans and the estimates be approved. I shall feel it a great favour if this be kindly treated urgent.

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

C.A. 131.—Piers, end bays of verandah, arch rings, and keys, to be of table-moulded, kiln-burned brick in chunam, pointed. Spandrels shown dotted on elevation may be kiln-burned brick coated with rough plaster (stucco).

Roofing.—Mangalore tiles with teak reepers over upstairs portion; ordinary terrace roofing over single-storied portion.

Note.—The original plan, by A. Parthasarady Mudaliyar, shows walls unnecessarily thick, and doesn't comply with brick sizes. Stairs are not protected from rain, and not conveniently planned. Piers of verandah are thin in proportion to span of arches. Ornamental eaves board and ridge would be better omitted. No turn or collars shown. Posts supporting ends of tiled roof upstairs do not come over any wall or support underneath. Hence Consulting Architect's revised design (No. 131).
