I have the honour to request you to be so good as to obtain the sanction of Government for an increase from Rs 2 to Rs 4 of the rent allowance of the office of the Sub Assistant Inspector of Schools, Madura Range, with effect from ~~3-11~~ 1st May 1907.

2. The present rent allowance of Rs 2 per mensem has been sanctioned by the Director with reference to G.O. No. 835 Educational dated 30th November 1892, but the Inspector of Schools, Fourth Circle, recommends a rent allowance of not less than Rs 5 per mensem on the ground that the rent of the house which accommodates the Sub Assistant as well as his office has been raised by the landlord from Rs 8 to Rs 14 from 8th May 07

and that no other suitable building for a less rent is available in Madura which has ^{now} become proverbial for exorbitance in house rent. As the Sub Assistant might reasonably be expected to pay for his own accommodation a monthly rent of Rs 10/- it is proposed to charge the excess of Rs 4 to the office, and this distribution is, I consider, very fair especially in view of the fact that about one half of the building has been utilized for the office.

3. If the increase is sanctioned the usual reappropriation statement in respect of the extra charge during the current year will be obtained and sanctioned by the Director.

SUBJECT.

Proposal to increase from Rs 2 to Rs 4, the house rent allowance of the Sub-assistant Inspector of Schools, Madura Range.

The D.P.I. requests sanction to the increase in from Rs 2 to Rs 4 ^{per m.} of the rent allowance of the office of the Sub-assistant Inspector of Schools, Madura Range, from the 8th May 1907.

2. The allowance of Rs 2 per m. was sanctioned by the D.P.I. under the authority delegated to him by G.O. No. 835 Educational, dated 30th November 1892. The grounds for the proposed increase of rent allowance are

- (1) that the rent of the house which now accommodates the Sub-assistant Inspector and his office was raised by the landlord from Rs 8 to Rs 14 from 8th May 1907; and
- (2) that no other suitable building for a less rent is available in Madura which has now become proverbial for exorbitance in house rent.

3. The Inspector of Schools IVth Circle, recommends an allowance of Rs 5 per m;

but

but the D.P. 9. Considers that Rs 4 per mensem is a fair allowance having regard to the portion of the building occupied by the office of the Sub-assistant and recommends that this sum may be sanctioned.
