NOTIFICATION.

Public Service Notification.

In the revised Public Service Notification add to paragraph 4 under "Powers of Exemption"—

(10) The Director of Industrial and Technical Inquiries may sanction the employment of unpassed candidates in acting and *sub. pro tem.* vacancies in his office, and in temporary posts under him for a period of one year, provided the salaries attached to the appointments do not exceed Rs. 25 per mensem.

(11) Special Settlement-officers in the Revenue Department may sanction the employment of unpassed candidates as acting, *sub. pro tem.* or temporary classifiers without limit of time.

The following notification will be published in the *Fort St. George Gazette* :—

NOTIFICATION.

The following will be added as clauses (10) and (11) to article 4 of the Public Service Notification :—

(10) The Director of Industrial and Technical Inquiries may sanction the employment of unpassed candidates in acting and *sub. pro tem.* vacancies in his office and in temporary posts under him—

(a) when the vacancy does not exceed twelve months in duration,

(b) when the acting allowance, exclusive of any local allowance, is not more than Rs. 25 per mensem.

Provided that *bonâ fide* efforts have been made without success to obtain passed candidates.

(11) Special Settlement-officers may sanction the employment of unpassed candidates as acting and *sub. pro tem.* classifiers without limit of time.

In the revised Public Service Notification add to para 4 under "Powers of Exemption" -

(10) The Director of Industrial and Technical Inquiries may sanction the employment of unpassed candidates in acting and sub-protein vacancies in his office, and in temporary posts under him
(a) when the vacancy does not exceed 12 months in duration,
(b) when the acting allowance, ^{exclusive of any local allowance} attached to the appointments do not exceed Rs 25/- per mensem.

(11) Special settlement officers in the Revenue Department may sanction the employment of unpassed candidates as ^{and} acting, sub-protein [or temporary] classifiers without limit of time.
