The H. Hawkes, who has not ^{in Nov: last} passed any examination, was appointed ^{as Nursery Overseer} of the Govt Botanical gardens, Ootacamund, on the 25-1-35. As the appointment required exemption from the examination rules, the exemption was granted for 6 months in G.O. 83 Encl 7/1-2-08. The intention was to exempt Hawkes permanently from the examination rules if, after the period of probation, ~~he was found~~ he was found fit to be confirmed in the post.
