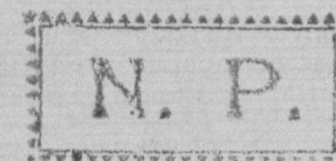

I am directed to forward for the information of the Governor in Council a copy of a despatch from the Secretary of State, No. 8, Public (Records), dated the 28th February 1908, and of its enclosure, regarding a request which has been made by the Committee of Educational Research of the University College of Bristol, to be furnished periodically with copies of official reports and publications relating to Education in India.

2. I am to request that, with the permission of the Governor in Council, the Committee may be supplied regularly in future with a copy of the undermentioned publications :—

- (i) Annual Provincial Report on Public Instruction;
- (ii) Provincial Educational Codes and Manuals, with copies of all future amendments as issued; and
- (iii) The Madras University Calendar.

3. I am to ask that a copy of the latest issue of the publications enumerated in the preceding paragraph may be supplied direct to the Committee.

I forward herewith, for such action as Your Excellency's Government may deem suitable, a copy of an application from the Committee of Educational Research of the University College of Bristol to be furnished periodically with copies of official reports and publications relating to education in India, and to be placed in communication with some correspondent who would provide them with supplementary information on that subject.

The Committee of Educational Research of the University College of Bristol is in process of forming a Library of Reports, Regulations, Programmes of Studies, Circulars and official publications issued by the authority of Ministries of Education for the control of Public Instruction.

2. It is their hope that the Library, when established, will be fully representative of the organisation of Education in England and in the English Colonies, and that arrangements may be concluded by which such publications as I have referred to above will be forwarded to their Library annually.

3. I am commissioned to ask whether the Indian Government will consent to co-operate in the undertaking of the Committee by supplying the material necessary for the establishment of a section of the Library assigned to the organisation of Education in India.

4. The Committee is further desirous of being introduced to a correspondent who will consent to provide them with supplementary information with regard to the progress of Education in India as he may judge to be of special interest.

The Superintendent, Government Press, will be requested to supply the Committee of Educational Research of the University College of Bristol, regularly in future, with a copy of the Report on Public Instruction, commencing with the report for the quinquennium ending the 31st March 1907.

2. The Director of Public Instruction will be requested to furnish the Committee direct with a copy of the latest issue of the Madras Educational Rules, the Grant-in-Aid Code, and the Code of Regulations for European Schools with all amendments up to date and to send a copy of all future amendments as they are issued.

3. The University of Madras will be requested to state whether they will furnish a copy of the Madras University Calendar to the Committee.

At the instance of the Secretary of State for India, the Government of India request that the Committee of Educational Research of the University College of Bristol may be supplied regularly in future with a copy of the undermentioned publications:—

- (i) Annual Provincial Report on Public Instruction;
- (ii) Provincial Educational Codes and Manuals, with copies of all future amendments as issued; and
- (iii) The Madras University Calendar.
