He enlisted in the 2nd Battalion Scots Guards, served throughout the South African war (both medals with 3 clasps) and

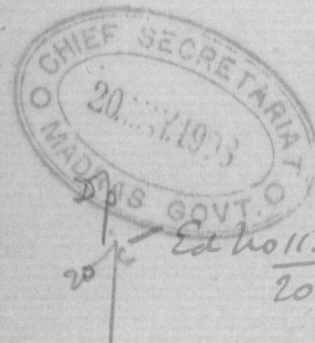
