Mr. O'Grady,—To ask the Secretary of State for India, whether he is aware of the fact that the Government of Madras refused to accept the recommendation of the senate of the university for the affiliation of the Basel German Mission High School, Calicut, as a second-grade college; and whether, having regard to the fact that the one college in Calicut (Zamorin's College) admits only students of high-class communities, excluding the Thiyyas, a large community, and that over 50 per cent. of the students at the Basel German Mission High School are members of the Thiyyas community, and who, by this decision of the Government of Madras in refusing to accept the recommendation of the senate, are deprived of the opportunities of higher education, he will inquire into the matter with a view of this decision being reconsidered.
