The Governor in Council resolves to delegate to the Director of Public Instruction the powers which are now vested in the Local Government by articles 36, 39, 44 (d), 90 and 104 of the Code of Regulations for European schools and under article 14 of the Code, as amended, is pleased to sanction the following modification in the Code:—

(1) In articles 36, 39, 44 (d) and 104, for the words "Local Government" substitute the words "Director of Public Instruction".

(2) In article 90 for the words "Local Governments" substitute the words "The Director of Public Instruction".

2. *Public Service Notification*—Orders have issued raising the minimum salary of appointments for which a general education test is required from Rs. 15 to Rs. 20—*vide* G.O., No. 226, Educational, dated 24th March 1908.

3. *Powers to be delegated to the Director of Public Instruction—Items 6 to 14 and 16.*—Orders have already issued in regard to these items—*vide* G.Os., No. 336, Educational, dated 6th May 1908, No. 277, Educational, dated 20th April 1908 and No. 270, Educational, dated 8th April 1908.
